Stadium Entrance

The 1878 Brasserie is accessed via the Goodison Road Stand.

Hospitality opening hours

The 1878 Brasserie opens 3 hours before kick-off and will close 1 hour after the final whistle.

Dining

Your meal will be served on arrival, up to 1 hour prior to kick off.

Dietary Requirements

Should you have any special dietary requirements please contact us at least ten days prior to the fixture.

Alcohol

The Club reserves the right to refuse alcohol to anyone that may appear intoxicated. It is the ticket holder's responsibility to ensure all guests behave responsibly.

Dress Code

Everton operates a smart casual dress code. No tracksuits, sportswear, caps, shorts, trainers (of any variety) football shirts, ripped or bleached jeans are allowed. The above dress code does not apply to children under the age of 12, we do ask that all children are dressed smartly. The club has the right to refuse admission to any person wearing clothing deemed inappropriate. Strictly no away colours or offensive clothing.

Stadium Smoking Policy

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes is also prohibited.

Entry and exit policy

Failure to provide the relevant ticket upon arrival will result in you being refused entry to the Stadium. For safety reasons guests are not permitted re-entry to the stadium under any circumstances.

Parking

VIP car parking provided 1 per 4 guests.

Fixture Changes

Dates and times of fixtures are subject to change, sometimes at short notice. Every effort will be made to keep you informed, but we cannot be responsible for changes.

Away fans

The 1878 Brasserie is in an area exclusive to home fans. If you or any of your guests support a visiting team, please behave in an appropriate manner and do not make your allegiance known in any way.

Luggage

Due to security reasons large bags are not permitted into the stadium. Along with electronic devices larger than 150mm x 100mm which are prohibited, including laptops and tablets. We suggest you do not bring any bags larger than an A4 sheet of paper.
