One of the most recognizable faces on Sky Sports News and Sky News, Pete is a safe pair of hands for hosting any corporate party, awards or dinner event.

As well as being a news broadcaster, Pete has hosted numerous live football and rugby matches on Sky, has had his own radio shows on Metro Radio, Real Radio and Radio Tyneside, and has written, produced and presented a one hour tribute to legendary England, Barcelona and Newcastle Utd manager, Sir Bobby Robson.

In 2017 Sophy published The Women Who Shaped Politics, a book on the history of women in Westminster.
